Inspection Services

The iPad inspection is followed by an electronic report outlining the areas needing attention. This also includes a parts and service quotation if required. Any maintenance or replacement parts authorized by the customer are then scheduled for a future repair date and given a single, **exclusive 10% promo discount**. Upon completion of all parts and service work, the customer will receive an approved inspection decal for each machine.

Optional Inspection Services

Option 1: Preventative Maintenance 1

Includes:

- Grease lube fittings on sheave pins (if applicable)
- Grease steering pivot points
- Grease trunnion pin if greaseable type
- Adjust and lube hoist chains if applicable and serviceable
- Adjust and lube drive chains if applicable and serviceable
- Adjust cable tension on block adjust wire rope
- Lubricate hoist wire rope
- Change filters (hydraulic oil filters, engine oil filter, fuel filter, air filter) *
- Change hoist gear reducer oil*
- Change drive gear reducer oil*
- Change non drive gear reducer oil*
- Change oil in hoist brakes if applicable*
- Change oil in drive brakes if applicable*
- Change oil in pump drive if applicable*
- Change engine oil*
- Check anti freeze level and strength
- Align steering
- Check and adjust tire pressure

*Customer to provide OEM filters to be onsite prior to technician's arrival. The customer will be responsible for supplying engine oil, gear oils, wire rope lube and disposing of all fluids. Marine Travelift will supply grease and grease gun. Contact Marine Travelift CustomerCare for recommended oil/lube specifications.



Option 2: Preventative Maintenance 2

Includes Option 1 (Preventative Maintenance 1) and a hydraulic reservoir oil change.**

Option 3: Oil Sample Testing

Includes a hydraulic oil sample analysis. Marine Travelift will obtain a hydraulic oil sample and send it to a third party testing facility for analysis. An oil sample report will be supplied once testing is complete.

Option 4: Operator/Maintenance Training

A Marine Travelift factory technician will perform basic operator/maintenance training with on-site personnel.

All attendees will receive operator training certificates upon completion.

Option 5: Jib Crane Inspection

Includes a function test and an inspection of the gear box lube level, wire rope, hydraulic system, operation/safety decals, safety functions, wear pads, swing slew bearing, and more.

**The customer will be responsible for supplying all hydraulic oil to replenish the reservoir and system and for disposing of all fluids. Contact Marine Travelift CustomerCare for recommended oil/lube specifications.
